Children must be supervised at all times. Please read this list of rules to all children using the bounce house.

SPECIFIC RULES TO FOLLOW:

1. Compatible age groups must play on unit at the same time. Age groups must not be mixed. Different sized children must not be mixed.
2. The bounce house is designed for children and is not recommended for use by adults. The maximum number of children allowed in the standard 15' x 15' bounce house is:

Ages 2 to 8.....8 children maximum
Ages 9 to 13.....6 children maximum
Ages 14 to 17.....4 children maximum

The maximum number of children allowed in the standard 13' x 13' bounce house is:

Ages 2 to 8.....6 children maximum
Ages 9 to 13.....4 children maximum
Ages 14 to 17.....2 children maximum

5. All persons must remove shoes, glasses, jewelry, and anything else that may harm the bounce house.
6. No flips or somersaults.
7. No food or drink inside or near (within 10 feet) the bounce house.
8. Please do not cut the plastic ties on the front of the bounce house.
Please do not tape or fasten anything to the bounce house.

SHOULD THE BOUNCE HOUSE BEGIN TO DEFLATE:

1. If the motor has stopped—check the cord connection at the outlet and at the motor. Remember: use of more than one extension cord can trip the circuit breaker.
 2. If the motor continues to run—check the air intake on the side of the motor for blockage. Check both tubes on the back of the bounce house for snugness and re-tie if necessary.
- If you experience any other problems with the equipment, please page the representative at the phone number on the liability agreement.

CASTLE BOUNCER SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

1) LAY PROVIDED TARP OUT FLAT USING SMALL WEIGHTS (ROCK, STONE, ETC.) TO HOLD DOWN CORNERS.



2) PLACE ROLLED BOUNCER AT THE CENTER OF ONE END OF THE TARP.



3) UNDO STRAPS HOLDING BOUNCER.



4) ROLL OUT BOUNCER ACROSS TARP.



5) UNFOLD BOUNCER.

6) STRETCH CORNERS OF BOUNCER OUT ACROSS TARP.

STAKE ALL CORNERS!!



7) HOOK UP BLOWER TO ONE OF THE AIR INLETS. STRAP BLOWER ONTO INLET TUBE SECURELY.

8) CLOSE OTHER INLET TUBE USING ATTACHED STRAP.



9) TURN BLOWER ON.



10) BOUNCER WILL INFLATE IN LESS THAN 5 MINUTES.

11) BOUNCER IS READY FOR USE WHEN IT IS COMPLETELY FULL.

STAKE ALL CORNERS!!



12) TO DEFLATE, REMOVE BLOWER AND OPEN BOTH AIR TUBES.

13) SPREAD VINYL OUT EVENLY ACROSS BOUNCER. THIS WILL MAKE IT EASIER TO ROLL AND FIT INTO BAG.



14) FOLD UNIT BACK TOGETHER. RELEASE AIR FROM BOUNCER AND SMOOTH VINYL TO REDUCE BUNCHING WHEN UNIT IS ROLLED.



15) FOR 13' X 13' BOUNCER FOLD UNIT IN THIRDS. FOR 15' X 15' BOUNCER FOLD IN QUARTERS.

16) ROLL UNIT TIGHTLY. STRAP ROLL TOGETHER, AND PLACE BOUNCER BACK IN BAG.





Guidelines for **INFLATABLES**

So everyone can have fun and be safe!

1. Select an area clear of all structures, trees, overhead wires, stumps, rocks, animal droppings, etc.
2. Use a tarp under the inflatable; do not inflate it directly on the ground.
3. After it's inflated, anchor each corner of the inflatable with the stakes and ropes provided. Do not use the inflatable without anchoring it.
4. Leave the blower running continuously until you need to deflate the unit.
5. Inflatables are designed for use by children. Adults are generally too heavy and could be injured or injure others. Adults are not permitted on the inflatable.
6. Children must be physically able to use the inflatable.
7. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
8. Group children by size; do not allow different sized children on the inflatable at the same time.
9. Limit the number of children using the inflatable at the same time.
10. Remove shoes before using the inflatable.
11. Follow all rules listed on side of inflatable.
12. No sharp or hard objects (glasses, jewelry, watches, shoes, casts, etc.) are permitted on the inflatable. Remove all items from pockets.
13. No flips, somersaults or body slamming allowed.
14. Jumping is only allowed inside the area enclosed by the safety netting. Do not jump on the loading platform.
15. Food, drink, gum, candy, etc. are choking hazards and therefore not permitted while using the inflatable.
16. Do not permit children to play near the fan or behind the rear of the unit where they cannot be readily supervised.
17. To prevent the spread of germs, children should wash their hands and faces after using the inflatable.
